1. The issue in both these contempt petitions is in respect of disobedience of the directions issued by the High Court vide order dated 10.01.2019 passed in **DB Civil Writ Petition No.9122/2018** and connected writ petition, which were followed and reiterated in an another DB Civil Writ Petition No.4300/2019, decided vide order dated 22.08.2019. The directions have been issued to the State Government to extend parity of pay to the petitioners with the Senior Munsarims in the Subordinate Courts.

2. It has been pointed out that the State Government filed a **Special Leave to Appeal (C) No.19994/2019: The State of Rajasthan Vs. Rajesh Kumar Jain**, which has been dismissed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, vide order dated 16.12.2025.

3. Learned counsel, appearing on behalf of Additional Advocate General, states at bar that the issue has been taken up for compliance, after sustaining directions of the High Court and dismissing SLPs filed thereagainst, by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, vide order dated 16.12.2025, and the file has been forwarded by the Department of Law to Finance Department, although, no such written letter has been placed on record.

4. Principal Secretary, Law and Legal Affairs Department, Government of Rajasthan, is directed to remain present before this Court, either in person or through VC, on the next date of hearing.

5. In D.B. Civil Contempt Petition No. 1126/2024, counsel for the petitioner undertakes to file amended cause title in course of the day.

After filing of the amended cause title, same be placed at appropriate place.

6. In D.B. Civil Contempt Petition No. 64/2026, let notice of contempt petition be issued to respondent No.3 and notices be also sent on his E-mail.

In addition, learned Additional Advocate General, appearing on behalf of respondent No.1 is directed to seek instructions to appear on behalf of respondent No.3 as well.

7. List these contempt petitions on 10th February 2026 in supplementary list.



8. Registrar (Judicial) is also directed to send copy of this order to the Principal Secretary, Law and Legal Affairs Department, Government of Rajasthan, for compliance.
