1. Principal Law Secretary is present-in-person and is not able to give a proper explanation for non-compliance of the orders of this Court which have been affirmed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court.
2. Additional Advocate General appearing on behalf of Finance Secretary, Finance Department, Government Secretariat, Jaipur, as well seeks some time for compliance of the order.
3. This Court, vide order dated 29.01.2026, taking note of the fact that the final order of High Court dated 10.01.2019 has been

affirmed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court vide order dated 16.12.2025, on the assurance of Additional Advocate General, granted time for compliance. Thereafter, again the contempt was taken up on 10.02.2026 and further time was granted. Today as well, without producing any document and assigning proper explanation, time has been prayed for, which appears to be uncalled for and *prima facie* gives reflection that the Authorities are not sincere enough to make compliance of the orders of the High Court.

4. We hope and trust that, Authorities concerned including Finance Secretary and Principal Law Secretary, shall extend heed and would take required and necessary steps with all sincerity to make compliance of the orders of High Court, in order to escape from the rigour of contempt, else inaction on their part shall be considered contumacious and disrespectful, towards the order of the High Court.

5. In the interest of justice and on the request of Principal Law Secretary, who is present-in-person, a week's time is granted to do the needful, else the appropriate orders against the erring Officers shall be passed.

6. In case of non-compliance of the orders within a period of one week, the Principal Law Secretary and Finance Secretary, Finance Department, Government Secretariat, Jaipur, shall remain present-in-person before this Court.

7. Let the contempt petitions be listed on 12.03.2026 in supplementary list.

8. Copy of the order be sent to the Finance Secretary, Finance Department, Government Secretariat, Jaipur forthwith for compliance.
