During the course of arguments, it has been indicated by learned Senior Counsel that in compliance of judgment given by this Court in S.B. CWP Nos. 7953/2019 and 18671/2018, one Committee of Higher Level Officers was constituted for the purpose of re-determination of vacancies on the post of Head Constable for the year 2013-14. Learned counsel refers to order dated 27.03.2023 wherein, there is a reference of report of the Committee on the basis of which, the respondents have allegedly re-determined the number of vacancies for the year 2013-14. It is submitted that copy of report has neither been supplied by the

respondents to the petitioners nor has it been placed on record.

Learned counsel submits that since, the Committee was constituted in compliance of order earlier passed by this Court therefore, dispute involved in these writ petitions cannot be decided properly without perusing the report of the Committee which may contain the reasons for the conclusion arrived at by the respondents.

Learned Additional Advocate General prays for a week time for filing report of Committee as referred in order dated 27.03.2023 along with additional affidavit.

List this matter on 25th March, 2026 along with S.B. CWP No. 6096/2023.

In the meantime, learned Additional Advocate General may file copy of report along with additional affidavit with advance copy to learned counsel for the petitioner.
