1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that during pendency of this petition, parties have resolved their dispute amicably and entered into compromise. Counsel further submits that an application under Section 13B of Hindu Marriage Act has already been filed in the court of Additional District Judge Badi, Dholpur. He submits that complainant-respondent No.2 has

already received Rs.13,00,000/- by way of bank draft. He submits that now complainant-wife is not turning up to endorse the compromise.

2. In view of the above submissions, issue notice to the respondents.

3. Learned State counsel accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State. Copy of this petition has already been supplied in his office.

4. Let notice be issued to respondent No. 2, through both the processes, returnable by next date of hearing. Requisites be filed within a period of 10 days, failing which, this petition shall stand dismissed automatically without any further reference to the bench.

5. List this case on 22.07.2024. Till the next date of hearing, further investigation arising out of FIR No.444/2022 registered at Police Station Bhusawar, District Bharatpur shall remain stayed.
