1. Learned counsel for the petitioner stated that candidature of the petitioner has been rejected by respondent-Rajasthan Public Service Commission vide letter dated 08.09.2025 for the reason that the petitioner has not allegedly submitted record of having represented the university/college at the inter-university/inter-collegiate competitions or the State and/or national championships.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner indicated from the application form that while applying in the category of 'outstanding sports person', he specified in the application form that he had participated in the National Tournament of Hockey and in support thereof, he has also placed the relevant certificates possessed by him.

3. Reply to the writ petition has been filed by respondent-Commission stating therein that the petitioner had not submitted any Inter University/Inter college game certificate along with detailed application form; however no statement whatsoever has

been given in reply as to whether the certificates with regard to State or National championship were submitted by the petitioner or not.

4. In reply to the writ petition it has also been submitted that on the date of submitting the application form, the petitioner was over aged.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that as the petitioner was in service of Education Department of Government of Rajasthan, therefore, he would be entitled to relaxation of age, and petitioner cannot be said to be an over age candidate.

6. Learned counsel for the respondent-Commission sought time to file detailed affidavit.

7. Time prayed for is granted.

8. Let the matter be listed on 24.04.2026.

9. In the meanwhile, the respondents shall permit the petitioner for document verification process provisionally. It is made clear that such provisional verification shall create any equity in favour of the petitioner and shall be subject to decision of this writ petition.
