On the directions of the Hon'ble Acting Chief Justice, the matters have been assigned to the regular rosters for hearing.

The instant matters pertain to the advertisement dated 22.10.2019 for the post of Veterinary Officer under the Rajasthan Animal Husbandry Service Rules, 1963.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has relied upon the dictum encapsulated by the Hon'ble Apex Court in **Civil Appeal No.14112/2024** titled **Rajasthan High Court & Anr. Versus Rajat Yadav & Ors.** and has submitted that the issue in consideration therein which was dealt by the Hon'ble Apex Court is on the same lines as that of the dispute in the instant matters and therefore the same is no more *res integra*.

Howsoever, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State as well as R.P.S.C. have raised strong preliminary objections *qua* the maintainability of the present writ petitions. It is submitted that the petitioners have approached the Court after an inordinate delay as the said recruitment process has already been concluded much prior to the filing of the present petitions. Moreover, it is submitted that the ambit and the applicability of the relied judgment passed by the Hon'ble Apex Court in the present case is highly disputed.

Considering that bunch of petitions are involved and with the mutual consensus of respective parties, instant matters can be

taken up on a single day *qua* the aforesaid recruitment on 19.01.2026 at 02:00 PM in the supplementary cause list.

Learned counsel representing RPSC has supplied a list of petitions which are of akin nature.

Accordingly, list the matters on 19.01.2026 at 02:00 PM along with S.B.CWPNos.14328/2020, 14577/2020, 5209/2020, 161/2021, 18774/2023, 12003/2023, 19715/2023, 20155/2023, 20581/2023, 103/2024, 835/2024, 2431/2024, 7772/2024, 10457/2024, 19720/2023, 20191/2023, 250/2024 & 4989/2024 in the supplementary cause list.
