Learned counsel for the petitioners have argued that while the alleged date of execution of the bond by the petitioners is shown to be 28.11.2022, the seal of the said stamp paper on which the said bond has been issued is dated 21.06.2023 and even the date on which the said stamp paper was sold by the stamp vendor to the petitioners is 30.06.2023 and both these dates are much after the alleged date of execution of the bond, which is 28.11.2022.

Learned counsel submits that this sole fact establishes that not only the bond is antedated but also reflects the intent of the respondents. Learned counsel has also placed reliance upon the State-wise Bond Info published by MCC, which *qua* the State of Rajasthan, provides that 'No Bond For Anatomy, Biochemistry Pharmacology, PSM, Physiology and Forensic Medicine' is required.

Learned counsel for the respondents seeks time to file reply.

As a last indulgence, time prayed for is granted and while replying to the averments made in the writ petition, learned counsel for the respondents is also expected to file a specific affidavit *qua* the submissions with respect to date of execution of the bond.

List the matter on 10.02.2026.
