An application No. 01/2026 has been filed by the petitioner for dispensing with the service of notice upon respondent Nos. 4 and 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not claiming any relief qua the respondent Nos. 4 and 5 and therefore, service of notice upon respondent Nos. 4 and 5 may be dispensed with.

In view of the submissions made by the counsel for the petitioner and the averments made in the application No. 01/2026, the same is allowed.

Accordingly, service of notice upon respondent No. 4 and 5 is dispensed with at the risk and cost of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that because of the impugned order passed by the Court below the petitioner who is daughter-in-law of the respondent Nos. 1 and 2 along with her

five year old son has been ousted from the house and they are taking shelter at their relatives residents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner being a daughter-in-law of the respondent Nos. 1 and 2 has a right to reside in the house because after her marriage she left her parent's house with an assurance by the respondent Nos. 1 and 2 that they will keep the petitioner with them with full dignity.

Mr. Lokesh Tiwari, has put an appearance on behalf of respondent No. 1 submits that the petitioner has no right to reside in the property / residential house which has been purchased by him.

The matter requires to be considered in detail, therefore, list the matter on 27.02.2026 for final disposal.

Looking to the peculiar facts of the case that daughter-in-law of the respondent Nos. 1 and 2 along with grandson of them has to take shelter at their relative's residence, this Court deems just and proper to direct the respondent Nos. 1 and 2 to allow the petitioner and her son to reside at their residence and they shall provide a separate room for them till disposal of the petition.
