Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that false recovery of contraband substance i.e., prohibited medicines has been shown to be made from the possession of the petitioner. Counsel submits that the petitioner was already in police custody as he was taken from his house at 07:39 PM on 06.05.2025 which is evident from the CCTV footage. It is submitted that the petitioner filed an application before the learned trial Court to ensure a fair and impartial investigation but Investigating Agency did not investigate the case fairly and without taking into

consideration the CCTV footage, filed the charge-sheet against the petitioner. Counsel submits that a representation was also submitted by the mother of the petitioner before the Superintendent of Police, District Karauli and after considering the said representation, Additional SP, Hindaun City was directed to conduct an inquiry in this matter.

Learned State Counsel is directed to call for the report with regard to the inquiry conducted by the Additional SP, Hindaun City on the representation/complaint filed by the mother of the petitioner on the next date of hearing.

List this case on 20.01.2026.

Till the next date of hearing, learned trial Court shall not proceed with the trial against the petitioner.
