Order

1. By way of filing the instant criminal misc. petition, a prayer has been made for issuing directions to the Investigating Officer for conducting fair and impartial investigation of FIR No.343/2023, registered with Police Station Ranoli, District Sikar for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468, 471 and 120B IPC.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during pendency of the instant petition, Final Report (Negative) was submitted. Thereafter, an application was submitted by the petitioner before the Court of Judicial Magistrate No.3, Sikar seeking further investigation in the aforementioned FIR. In the said application, the learned Magistrate vide order dated 20.08.2024 directed the Investigating Officer to conduct further

investigation with regard to certain points formulated by the Court concerned. Counsel submits that the aforesaid order was passed more than 18 months ago, but till date, no further investigation has been done, hence appropriate orders be passed.

3. *Per contra*, learned Public Prosecutor opposes the prayer and submits that after receipt of the aforesaid order dated 20.08.2024 passed by the Judicial Magistrate No.3, Sikar, the matter was reopened by the Investigating Officer for conducting the point-wise investigation as directed by the concerned Magistrate. Counsel submits that as per the factual report received from the Station House Officer, Police Station, Ranoli, District Sikar, the investigation is going on and the Investigating Officer is in process of collecting the material evidence. Hence, there is no need for issuing further directions.

4. Heard and considered the submissions made at Bar and perused the material available on record.

5. Considering the arguments put forward by counsel for the petitioner as well as the Public Prosecutor and looking to the fact that after submission of Final Report (Negative) in the instant matter, the learned Magistrate has directed the Investigating Officer to further investigate the matter on certain points while passing the order dated 20.08.2024 and in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the Investigating Officer is conducting further investigation, hence, under these circumstances, this Court does not deem it just and proper to issue further directions.

6. However, it is expected from the Investigating Officer to make all possible endeavours to speed up the investigation and



submit the conclusion report before the concerned Court expeditiously, as early as possible in accordance with law.

7. With the aforesaid observations, the instant criminal misc. petition stands disposed of. Stay application as well as all pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
