1. Instant writ petition is filed with following prayer:-

*a) By an appropriate writ, order and direction in
the nature thereof the impugned order dated
17.11.2025 may kindly be quashed and set aside
and the petitioner may kindly be granted one more
chance/liberty to submit representation in respect
of suspension order dated 07.02.2023 and
respondents may be directed to review the*

suspension and communicate the same to the petitioner within next 12 weeks from the date of receipt and further order may kindly be passed that till decision is under review interim order dated 01.12.2023 shall remain effective as directed by this Hon'ble Court vide order dated 29.08.2025 in earlier writ petition.

2. Learned counsel for petitioner while referring order dated 29.08.2025 in **S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.18145/2023** titled as **Ummed Singh Vs. State of Rajasthan** submits that earlier, writ petition filed by petitioner was disposed of by this Hon'ble Court on 29.08.2025, whereby a liberty was granted to the petitioner to submit a representation within a period of four weeks, but due to sudden illness of father of petitioner, he could not submit a representation within stipulated time and the suspension order was revive by the respondents.

3. Learned counsel for petitioner has further submitted that now the petitioner is ready to submit representation pursuant to order dated 29.08.2025 before the Competent Authority (respondents) and additional two weeks' time be permitted for filing of such representation in terms of order dated 29.08.2025.

4. Learned counsel, Mr. Archit Bohra, AGC appearing on behalf of respondents submits that he is agreed to further two weeks' time but without commitment on merits.

5. Having considered submission and also material placed on record, the writ petition is disposed of with further liberty to the petitioner to submit representation pursuant to order dated 29.08.2025 in **S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.18145/2023** titled as **Ummed Singh Vs. State of Rajasthan (supra)** to the

respondents. The respondents shall consider the representation as directed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court on 29.08.2025 and pass appropriate order and provide a copy of the decision taken on the representation.

6. With aforesaid, the writ petition and misc. application, if any, stands disposed of.
