1. The instant petition has been preferred with the prayer for issuing directions to the Investigating Officer for conducting fair and impartial investigation of the impugned F.I.R. No.273/2023 registered with the Police Station Pahadi, District Bharatpur offences punishable under Section 365 IPC.

2. At the outset, learned Public Prosecutor apprised this Court, on the basis of the factual report dated 08.02.2024 received from the Station House Officer, Police Station Pahadi, District Deeg, that after investigation, the Police has submitted the Final Report (Negative) in the instant matter, hence, under the changed circumstances, the instant petition has become infructuous.

3. Considering the above factual aspect of the matter, the instant petition is dismissed as having become infructuous granting liberty to the petitioner to avail the remedies available to him under the law before appropriate forum of law.

4. Stay application as well as all pending application(s), if any, also stand dismissed.

5. The factual report dated 08.02.2024 furnished by the Station House Officer, Police Station Pahadi, District Deeg is ordered to be retained on record.
