While impugning the judgment and decree dated 30.08.2025 passed by the learned Additional District & Sessions Judge No.1, Jaipur Metropolitan - I, Jaipur, in Civil Suit No. 102/2012, (CIS No.117/2014), titled as '*Smt. Manu Sharma Vs. Bhom Singh*', whereby the suit filed by the appellant/plaintiff seeking possession, mesne profits, and permanent injunction was dismissed; learned counsel for the appellant submits that the learned Court below seriously erred in dismissing the suit, without appreciating the fact that the respondent has no valid title or ownership to retain possession of the suit property. Yet, the suit for possession has been dismissed. He therefore prays that the impugned judgment and decree dated 30.08.2025 may kindly be quashed and set aside.

2. Heard. The matter requires consideration.

3. Admit.

4. In view of the submissions made hereinabove, issue notice to the respondent, returnable within four weeks.
5. Notices be filed in two sets. Upon filing the same, one set be sent by ordinary post and another by registered post.
6. Let the record of the learned Court below be summoned.
7. List the matter after four weeks.
8. In the meantime, and until further orders, the parties are directed to maintain the status quo as it exists today, and the respondents are further restrained not to sell, alienate, transfer or create any third-party rights in respect of the suit property.
