1. The instant bail application has been filed by the petitioner under Section 483 BNSS who has been arrested in connection with the FIR No.136/2025 dated 09.11.2025 registered at the Police Station Batoda District Sawaimadhopur, for the offences under Sections 319(2), 318(4), 338, 336(3) and 340(2) of the BNS and Section 66-D of the IT Act.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case by alleging that the petitioner alongwith other persons opened an account and transferred the amount of Rs. 1,00,000/- (one lakh) in the account of one person namely Mohit Kumar Meena fraudulently. He further submits that the offences are triable by the Court of Magistrate and the petitioner is in custody since 12.11.2025 and the charge-sheet has

been filed. The charge-sheet is taken on record. He, thus, urges that the petitioner deserves to be released on bail.

3. *Per contra*, learned Public Prosecutor opposes the bail application, however, is not in a position to refute the fact that the offences are triable by the Court of Magistrate. The petitioner is in custody since 12.11.2025 and the charge-sheet has been filed.

4. Having considered the submissions advanced at Bar by learned counsel for the parties and having regard to the entirety of facts and circumstances of the case as available on record; and looking to the fact that trial may take a long time to conclude and, without expressing any opinion on the merits/demerits of the case, this Court deems it fit to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

5. Consequently, the bail application is allowed. It is ordered that the accused petitioner **Ramesh Singh S/o Laddulal**, arrested in connection with FIR 136/2025 dated 09.11.2025 registered at the Police Station Batoda District Sawaimadhopur, shall be released on bail; provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- and two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court, with a stipulation to appear before that Court on all dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.
