1. Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that the facts in the present writ petition are similar to the facts of S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 18819/2025 titled as ***Shashank Automobiles & Ors. Vs. Union of India & Ors.***, wherein on 03.12.2025 following order has been passed:-

"Heard.

Issue notice to the respondents.

Mr. S. S. Naruka, learned Additional Advocate General appears on an advance copy on behalf of respondent Nos. 2 to 4.

Hence, service upon respondent Nos.2 to 4 is complete.

Let notice be issued to respondent No.1 only.

Learned AAG prays for & is granted time to file reply to the writ petition.

*Learned counsel for the petitioners has relied upon an interim order passed by Hon'ble Division Bench at Principal Seat, Jodhpur in **D.B. Special Appeal (Writ) No.1453/2025 (State of Rajasthan & Ors. v. Udaipur Fitness Center & Anr.)**, whereby the Hon'ble Division Bench has passed the following order:-*

"3. In the meanwhile, it is directed that a detailed report shall be furnished regarding the establishment of Automated Testing Stations in conformity with the rules and office order dated



02.07.2025 as well as the status of the applications by the private person seeking establishment of Automated Testing Stations in conformity with the applicable rules.

4. It is also made clear that until such machinery is not there in a particular district, the respondent shall be allowed to operate in conformity with FIJA 2018 scheme through their automated machines."

Learned counsel for the respondents are not able to refute the fact that the above order is applicable to the present case.

In view of the above directions issued by the Hon'ble Division Bench, the respondents are accordingly directed to permit the petitioners to operate under the FIJA 2018 Scheme through automated machines up to the validity period as per the license /renewed license, if the automated testing stations are not established in the concerned District.

List along with S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.17898/2025 (Arihant Vehicle Fitness Center v. Union of India & Ors.)."

2. In view of the said submission, issue notice to respondents.
3. Mr. S.S. Naruka, learned Additional Advocate General appears on advance copy on behalf of respondents No.2 to 4, hence, notice need not be filed for them.
4. Let notice be filed for respondent No.1 only.
5. Learned Additional Advocate General prays for and is granted four weeks' time to file reply to the writ petition.
6. In the meanwhile, the respondents are directed to permit the petitioner to operate under the FIJA 2018 Scheme through automated machines up to the validity period as per the license / renewed license, if the automated testing stations are not established in the concerned District.
7. List the matter after four weeks.
