1. This anticipatory bail application has been filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 on behalf of accused-petitioner in connection with FIR No.146/2025 registered at Police Station Bhiwadi, District Bhiwadi for the offences under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468, 471, 379 & 120-B IPC.
2. During course of the arguments, counsel for the petitioner has placed before this Court order dated 07.08.2025 passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in S.B. Criminal Misc. (Petition) No.4432/2025 which has been filed by the petitioner in connection with the same criminal case.
3. The Co-ordinate Bench in para 5 of the order dated 07.08.2025 has observed as under:-

"Considering the nature of dispute between the parties and the main issue is in respect of



recovery of balance amount of the cost of scrap, petitioners are directed to join the investigation, however, in case Investigating Officer finds that custodial investigation is required, he shall serve an advance notice of three weeks' to the petitioners and till then, no coercive steps against the petitioners shall be taken."

4. In view of the observation of the Co-ordinate Bench as quoted above, the Court feels that it would be appropriate if both criminal misc. petition and the bail application filed by the petitioner be heard by the same Bench.

5. Registrar (Judicial) is directed to place the matter before the Hon'ble Acting Chief Justice for appropriate orders.

6. During the course of arguments, counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of direction of the Co-ordinate Bench in S.B. Criminal Misc. (Petition) No.4432/2025, the accused-petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer.

7. Learned Public Prosecutor does not dispute the fact that the accused-petitioner has once appeared before the Investigating Officer.

8. In view of the above, the Court deems just and proper to order that the accused-petitioner shall not be arrested in this case, till further orders.
