Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has duly paid the full license fee in respect of the Catering Stall Nos.R-7 at Platform No.2/3 and R-9 at Platform No.1 at Kota Railway Station. Counsel further submits that due to extensive construction and re-construction activities at the platforms, the petitioner was compelled to repeatedly shift stalls to commercially non-viable locations. As a result, the sales of the petitioner dropped drastically. Counsel further submits that the respondents are threatening to take action under Clause 7.5 of the Contract, which was never executed between the parties. Counsel also submits that multiple representations have been given to the respondents, however, no heed has been paid to the said representations.
