In compliance of the order dated 09.04.2026, Mr. Archit Bohra, learned AGC today provided the relevant merit list and other connected documents pertaining to the selection in question. He informs that some mistake was committed in preparing the category wise merit list. He further submits that they have done the re-examination and on the basis of it, they have prepared the revised select list according to which three candidates of the General category in the divorcee namely Archana Ramtawkyia Sharma (marks 78) (General Category), Rashmi Shrivastava (marks 55) (General Divorcee) and Deepika Bansal (marks 45) (General Divorcee) will be removed from the list as they do not fall in the merit.

He further submits that on account of removal of above three persons, new persons namely Khushbu Jasotani (72 marks) (OBC-NCL), Ajay Kumar Meena (61 marks) (ST) and Priyanka Meena

(59 Marks) (ST)(Divorcee) will now be included in the select list on the basis of the revision as done.

As far as the Respondent No. 4 is concerned, i.e., Deepika Bansal, who secured 45 marks, which is much lower than the score of the petitioner who secured 63 marks. Therefore, Respondent No. 4 on the basis of her marks, as noted by this Court from the record as well as from the arguments, does appears to be appointed not as per the merit. As far as the candidates namely Archana Ramtawkyia Sharma (marks 78) and Rashmi Shrivastava (marks 55) are concerned, they will be ousted on account of this revision exercise and they need to be heard before passing any order against them.

Mr. Tanveer Ahmed is directed to implead Archana Ramtawkyia Sharma (marks 78) and Rashmi Shrivastava (marks 55) as party respondents and file amended cause title.

On filing the same, let notices be issued to these persons returnable within a period of two weeks.

The petitioner is free to move appropriate application in reference to her grievance.

The documents as shown to this Court are taken on record, however, the learned AGC is directed to place these documents along with the proper application so that they can be taken on record.

List this case after two weeks.
