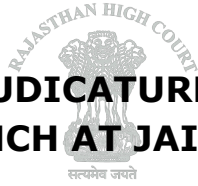

The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioners seeking directions to decide the Suit No.241/2016 titled as Harish @ Pintu & Another Vs. Smt. Vidhya Devi & Others, before the Court of Sub-Divisional Officer (SDO), Bundi.
