1. The present writ petition has been filed assailing the order dated 13.11.2025, passed by learned District Judge, Jaipur Metropolitan I, whereby the application filed by the applicant-petitioner under Order 7 Rule 14(3) CPC in the succession proceedings have been dismissed.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the documents which were required to be taken on record are very much relevant for the adjudication of the proceedings as the respondents are claiming their right on the basis of the Will whereas they had entered into an agreement to sell with one Vikram Tongia in which the existence of Will was not disclosed and the fact of the share of the petitioner was being admitted.
3. Therefore, he submits that these documents were necessary for the adjudication of the proceedings.
4. Heard.

5. Let notices be issued to the respondents 1/1 to Respondent No.6. Rule is made returnable within four weeks.
6. In the meanwhile further proceedings in succession proceedings No. 507/2016 pending before the Court of District Judge, Jaipur Metropolitan I, shall remain stayed.
7. This order will come into effect only after service on respondent.
8. List this matter after four weeks.
