Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondent No.2 – DISCOM, without intimation to the petitioner, changed the Current Transformer and Potential Transformer (CT-PT) ratio to 100/5A in place of 50/5A and accordingly, issued a demand notice for Rs.36,43,097/-.

Learned counsel further submits that subsequently vide Joint Inspection Report dt.31.10.2025, the CT-PT ratio was revised to the original one i.e. 50/5A, however, the demand was not revised pursuant to the revision of CT-PT ratio.

Learned counsel also submits that the application of the petitioner has been dismissed by the Corporate Level Consumer Grievance Redressal Forum vide order dated 17.09.2025, which came to the knowledge of the petitioner belatedly. Accordingly, the petitioner approached the Electricity Ombudsman within 30 days from the date of knowledge of the said order. However, the Electricity Ombudsman refused to register the appeal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already deposited 50% amount of the demand notice i.e. Rs.9,10,774/- as a 1st installment on 07.11.2025 and again Rs.9,10,774/- as a 2nd installment on 12.11.2025.

Heard.

Issue notice of writ petition as well as stay application to the respondent(s), returnable by four weeks.

List after four weeks.

Till the next date of hearing, the respondents are directed not to disconnect the electricity connection of the petitioner.
