1. Heard on review petition filed by the petitioner and perused the order dated 23.09.2025.

2. This Court finds that order dated 23.09.2025 has been passed on the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, which is reproduced as under:

"6. Learned counsel for the respondents has not disputed the fact that services of the petitioner are not governed by the Standing Orders of 1965, and are

regulated by the Regulations of 1965. He has also not disputed the fact that for the first time the power of issuing of compulsory retirement was inserted in the Regulations of 1965 on 06.09.2000, i.e. much after the date of order of compulsory retirement."

3. In view of above, the respondents/review petitioners at this stage cannot submit that the petitioners were not governed by the standing orders of 1965.

4. This Court finds that there is no error apparent in the case on record and the writ petition was decided by this Court on the basis of statements made by learned counsel for the parties appearing before this Court.

5. Accordingly, the review petition filed by the petitioner is hereby, dismissed.
