1. The petitioner has preferred this bail application under Section 483 of BNSS in FIR No.216/2025 registered at Police Station Balghat, District Karauli for offences under Sections 189(2) and 80(2) of BNS, 2023.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned Public Prosecutor and counsel for the complainant and perused the material available on record.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that the petitioner is not responsible for abetting the deceased in committing suicide. In fact, the petitioner was not present on spot at the time of the incident. The incident took place around five and a half years, after the marriage. The conclusion of the charge-sheet itself shows that the wife of the petitioner, the deceased,

was a short-tempered lady and, due to a dispute, she committed suicide herself. Petitioner is behind the bars since 10.10.2025. Charge-sheet has been filed. The trial of the case will take considerable time, therefore, no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in further custody consequently the bail application deserves to be allowed.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor and counsel for the complainant have vehemently opposed the bail application.

5. On consideration of the rival submissions and material available on record and in light of submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner but without expressing any opinion on merits/demerits of the case, I am inclined to grant benefit of bail to the petitioners.

6. Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed and it is directed that the petitioner **Shribhan @ Udamsingh S/o Late Samaysingh**, be released on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties in the sum of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court with the stipulation that he shall appear before that Court on all subsequent dates of hearing till conclusion of the trial.
