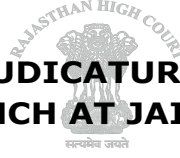

1. Heard on the application (IA No.1/2026) for interim bail.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the mother-in-law of the petitioner has expired on 02.01.2026, therefore, the petitioner has to perform the last rituals and related ceremonies. Hence, the petitioner may be released on interim bail for 15 days by allowing the interim bail application.
3. On the contrary, learned counsel appearing for the CBI has submitted that on an earlier occasion, the petitioner had already obtained an order in his favour dated 03.01.2026 from the Trial Court, whereby she was permitted to attend the funeral. Though she has not availed that opportunity, now on the same analogy, application for interim bail is not justified.



4. Having considered the rival arguments, it appears that the petitioner has already been granted bail for performing last rites. The present prayer for 15 days does not disclose any exceptional circumstances warranting further release, particularly in a case under the Prevention of Corruption Act. Therefore, I am not inclined to allow the present interim bail application.

5. Accordingly, the application (IA No.1/2026) for interim bail is hereby dismissed.
