HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE ANUROOP SINGHI**Order****24/02/2026**

1. The present writ petition has been filed with the following prayers:

"That in lieu of the above stated facts and circumstances the humble Petitioner prays Your Lordships may kindly be pleased to allow the writ petition filed by the petitioner and

1. Direct respondent No.2 to provide police assistance, preferably within two weeks, so that order dated 27.11.2024 passed by Ld Chief Judicial Magistrate Jaipur District Jaipur can be complied with so that petitioner can act as per law for the recovery of their dues.

2. That your Lordships may be pleased to pass any other order as they may deem fit and proper, in favour of the Petitioner in the interest of justice.

For this act of kindness and justice, the humble petitioner shall be duty bound and shall every pray."

2. Once the factum of the order dated 27.11.2024 passed by the Court of Senior Civil Judge and Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jaipur District, Jaipur in application No.325/2024 titled as Yes Bank Limited Vs. Satyanarayan Saini & Ors. is not disputed, there is no occasion for the respondents No.1 and 2 to refuse to provide police assistance to the petitioner for securing possession of the secured asset(s) as mentioned therein.

3. As a matter of fact, it is surprising that despite a specific judicial order having been passed in this regard, the same has not been complied with by the concerned authorities.

4. Taking note of the aforesaid facts, respondents No.1 and 2 are directed to ensure due compliance of the directions issued vide order dated 27.11.2024 within a period of four weeks from today

by providing requisite police assistance to the petitioner for securing possession of the secured asset(s) as mentioned in the said order.

5. With the aforesaid directions, the writ petition stands disposed of.

6. Pending application(s), if any, stands disposed of.
