1. The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioners under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, assailing the order dated 12.12.2025 passed by learned District Judge, Tonk, in Civil Miscellaneous Case (CIS) No. 22/2025, titled as "*Shivji Ram Sagiwal Vs. Trust Mandir Shri Chaturbhuji Maharaj*".

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that vide impugned order dated 12.12.2025, learned District Judge has dissolved the present office bearers/management committee of the trust and appointed Tehsildar, Tonk as a receiver which is beyond the scope of Section 40 of Rajasthan Public Trust Act, 1950. He further submits that the management of the temple is properly managed by the trustees, who are regularly performing *Sewa-Pooja*, and there is no imminent emergency, danger, or loss, so as to warrant the appointment of a Commissioner.

3. Heard.

4. In view of the submissions made hereinabove, issue notice to the respondents.
5. Notices be filed in two sets. Upon filing the same, one set be sent by ordinary post and another by registered post, returnable within four weeks.
6. Mr. Ajeet Bhandari, Senior Counsel, appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondents Nos. 1, 6 and 11. Ms. Neetu Mathur, learned counsel appears for Ms. Suman Shekhawat, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 26.
7. Hence, service upon respondents Nos. 1, 6, 11 and 26 is complete, and no notice need be issued to them.
8. Learned counsel for the respondents seeks time to file reply.
9. Time prayed for is granted.
10. List the matter after four weeks.
11. In the meanwhile, the status quo as exists today shall be maintained. The petitioners are further restrained from selling, alienating, or transferring or creating third-party interest in the suit property and further shall maintain the duly audited balance sheet in respect of the expenses of the trust properties.
