1. Instant appeal has been filed against order dated 16.09.2025 passed by learned Additional District Judge No.7, Jaipur Metropolitan-II in Civil Suit No.4/2025 (CIS No.221/2014) whereby suit filed by the plaintiff-appellant for possession of the property in dispute, has been dismissed.
