The matter comes up on application nos.1/2022, 2/2022, 3/2022, 4/2022 & 5/2022 filed under Order 22 Rule 3 CPC whereby prayer has been made that during the pendency of the contempt petition, the original petitioners i.e. petitioner no.4—Krishan Pal Singh Chauhan, petitioner no.17—Ramesh Chand Gupta, petitioner no.10—Smt. Vireshwari Devi, petitioner no.11—Amar Singh Rana & petitioner no.9— Smt. Chandwal Yadav have expired and as such legal representatives of the original petitioners need to pursue the contempt petition.
