

under ordinary process and speed post for which requisites be filed within two weeks.

Mr. Debalay Bhattacharya, learned senior counsel, appears for the Accountant General.

Mr. Bidyut Mjaumder, learned Deputy SGI, submits that Union of India was unnecessarily impleaded as a party in the writ petition though the writ petitioners are ex-employees of the State government. Their dispute relates to the pensionary dues with the State government and the office of the Accountant General. Therefore, the Union of India, be deleted from the array of respondents and his name be deleted from the Cause List.

Mr. Dipankar Sarma, learned Additional Government Advocate for the appellants-State, does not dispute that the *lis* does not involve the Union of India.

In that view of the matter, let the name of the respondent-Union of India be deleted from all the writ appeals by learned counsel for the appellants-State. Let the name of Mr. Bidyut Majumder, learned Deputy SGI, be also deleted from the Cause List henceforth.
