Heard Learned Counsel, Mr. Rishiraj Nath appearing on behalf of the petitioner. Also heard Learned Dy. SGI, Mr. Bidyut Majumder appearing on behalf of the respondents-Union of India.

The petitioner has filed the present writ petition challenging the order of the disciplinary authority for imposing the punishment of compulsory retirement to the petitioner which has been affirmed by the appellate authority.

It is the case of the petitioner that the punishment of compulsory retirement from service has been imposed upon the petitioner under Section 11 of the Central Reserve Police Force Act, 1949 (for short, CRPF Act) read with Rule 27 of the CRPF Rules but, in the relevant provision of the Act, there is no such procedure prescribed for compulsory retirement of a CRPF personnel. So, the punishment imposed upon the petitioner by the authority needs to be interfered with.

In view of the above, issue notice upon the respondents.

Since Learned Dy. SGI, Mr. Majumder appears and accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents, issuance of formal notice is waived.

Learned Dy. SGI for the respondents-Union of India further sought for an adjournment to take instruction.

Request is considered.

List the matter on **30.06.2026**. In the meantime, the respondents may file their reply, if they so desire, supplying copy to the other side.
