In this Writ Petition, petitioner has challenged the order
dt.15.07.2024 of the Central Administrative Tribunal, Guwahati Bench in
Miscellaneous Application No.041/00066/2024 filed by the petitioner

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herein, for condoning delay of 31 days in filing the Review Application No.041/00003/2024.

By placing reliance on the observation of the Supreme Court in *K Ajit Babu and others vs Union of India and others*¹ and its own judgment dt.08.06.2020 in M.A No.040/00140/19 and also the judgment of the Guwahati High Court dt.27.03.2023 in WP(C) No.3034/2021, the Central Administrative Tribunal held that it has no power to condone the delay in filing the Review Application.

We agree with the reasoning of the Tribunal that such a power to condone delay in filing a Review Application is not available to the Central Administrative Tribunal as Section 5 of the Limitation Act, 1963 is not made applicable to the said Tribunal.

Similar view has also been taken by the Allahabad High Court in its judgment dt.03.02.2026 in Miscellaneous Delay Condonation Application No.330/01710/2018.

Therefore, this Writ Petition is dismissed.

Pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
