Learned Counsel, Mr. A. Bhaumik appears for the petitioners.

It is the case of the petitioners that against the Advertisement No.04/2016 dated 30.04.2016, the petitioners applied for the post of TCS Grade-II and TPS Grade-II. Thereafter, they were qualified in the preliminary examination and after that they were called for in the main examination which they also qualified and after that they were called for interview. They appeared in the interview process. However, the TPSC after completion of the process by a notification dated 01.12.2025 forwarded the list containing the names of 45 candidates, 30 for the posts of TCS Grade-II and 15 for the posts of TPS Grade-II to the Government without recommending name of other candidates who have also secured the requisite marks in violation of Rule 9 and Rule 12 of the Tripura Civil Service and Tripura Police Service Rules and by another notification dated 16.12.2025 TPSC arbitrarily declared that the names of other candidates would not

be recommended which compelled the petitioners to file this writ petition.

Since Learned Sr. G.A., Mr. P. Gautam assisted by Learned Counsel, Ms. P. Chakraborty appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent Nos.1 and 2, formal notice upon those respondents is thus waived.

Let notice be issued upon respondent Nos.3 and 4.

The petitioners may take steps for service of notice upon the respondent Nos.3 and 4 both by normal process and also by registered A/D post within 7(seven) days and file proof of service.

In the meantime, the State-respondents shall file their counter-affidavit.

List the matter on **23.07.2026**.
