Heard Ld. Counsel Mr. K.Nath for the petitioners.

By Judgment dated 28.11.2025 passed in WP(C)No.652 of 2024, following directions were issued:

**“24. In view of the above, both the writ petitions are allowed. The respondents are directed to take necessary steps for absorption of above said petitioners of both the writ petitions in NESTS, following the due procedure within four weeks of receipt of copy of this judgment, and thereafter to complete the entire process of such absorption within a reasonable time, not later than 4 (four) months from the said date of receipt of copy of the judgment.”**

Ld. Counsel submits that despite a period of 4 months is over long ago, said judgment has not yet been complied with,

At this stage issue notice upon Respondent Nos.1, 2 and 3 to show cause as to why contempt proceeding shall not be initiated against them.
