Order

When the case is called, both the sides are present.

Mr. P. Gautam, learned Sr. G.A. has filed additional counter affidavit dated 17.01.2026 and made an attempt to convince this Court on the point of corrigendum dated 12.08.2022 i.e. Annexure R/3 of the counter affidavit notified in the Tripura Gazette wherein the schedule of land specified that an area measuring 0.040 acres of land comprising plot No.8258/1464/P of Khatian No.4248 was stated to be required instead of 0.021 acres of land of the same plot which was acquired by the acquiring department for the public utility.

It is seen from record that the documents i.e. Annexure R/1 and R/2 of the additional affidavit dated 17.01.2026 filed by respondents relate to the communication of the year 2022 asking for additional land which is the subject property to the writ petition. In the additional affidavit dated 17.01.2026, nowhere it is indicated as to the events that have transferred from 2022 to till 2026. On one hand, Mr. T.D. Majumder, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner submits before this Court that the land is still in the possession of the petitioner, per contra, Mr. P. Gautam, learned senior G.A. appearing for the State respondents submits that the land in question has already been taken over by the respondent officials and the same is under foot to use for development and the nature of land is also changed.

Since it is a fact that needs to be established before this Court by way of pleadings, this Court directs the respondents to file an affidavit providing all relevant details in the subject matter.

Mr. P. Gautam, learned Sr. G.A. appearing for the State seeks some reasonable time for submitting affidavit in this regard.

Request made by learned Sr. G.A. is considered. Respondents-State is directed to submit the affidavit as expeditiously as possible.

List the matter once such affidavit is filed on behalf of the respondents duly serving copy of the same to the learned counsel of the petitioner and the same is placed on record.
