Heard both sides.

As submitted by the Ld. Counsel of both sides, the pleadings of the parties are completed.

Accordingly, the writ petition is admitted.

During hearing Ld. Counsel, Mr. P. K. Pal further submits that the petitioner initially joined as "Overseer" and thereafter, his post was designated as Jr. Engineer Grade-II. Thereafter, he was also promoted as Jr. Engineer Grade-I, re-designated as Jr. Engineer, TES Grade-V(A).

Now, it is the grievance of the petitioner that the benefit of ACP -II and ACP-III were not granted to him. Ld. Counsel, Mr. Pal also submits that similar and identical matter are involved in WP(C) No. 661 of 2023 being heard simultaneously with some other identical cases have been adjourned sine-die vide order dated 12.01.2006 in view of the fact that the petitioner is heavily relying on a decision of

this Court passed in WP(C) No.191 of 2020 which was affirmed by the Division Bench in WA No.224 of 2021. Now, an SLP is pending and therefore, the decision of Hon'ble Supreme Court is awaited and hence this case may also be adjourned sine die.

The case is adjourned sine-die till decision of Hon'ble Supreme Court in the above said case.

The matter will be listed again, when any of the parties of this writ petition approaches this Court again on receipt of final decision of Hon'ble Supreme Court or for any other special reason.
