ORDER

05.12.2025

[1] Heard Mr. K. Pandey, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. P. Roy Barman, learned senior counsel appearing alongwith Mr. S. Bhattacharjee, learned counsel on behalf of the respondent contemnor. Both the parties are also present in the Court today.

[2] When the case is called, Mr. P. Roy Barman, learned senior counsel appearing for the respondent submits before this Court that till date, the respondent has paid Rs.5,50,000/- out of Rs.9,00,000/- as permanent alimony granted by this Court to the petitioner herein by order dated 04.08.2025 passed in Mat. App. No.15 of 2024. It is also contended that on 05.11.2025, last payment of Rs.2 lakhs was made by the respondent to the petitioner by cheque. He further submits that due to unavoidable and compelling circumstances, the respondent could not pay Rs.9 lakhs in 3 installments to the petitioner within 3rd July, 2025.

[3] Mr. Roy Barman, learned senior counsel appearing for the respondent, therefore, requests for granting some more months' time for making payment of the remaining amount of Rs.3,50,000/- out of the awarded permanent alimony of Rs.9,00,000/-to the petitioner.

[4] Considering the request made on behalf of the respondent contemnor, this Court directs him to clear the balance amount of Rs.3,50,000/- on or before 31st March, 2026 in three installments in the following manner:

- I. ***Rs.1,50,000/- shall be paid by the respondent to the petitioner as 1st installment on or before 31st January, 2026;***
- II. ***Rs.1,00,000/- shall be paid by the respondent to the petitioner as 2nd installment on or before 28th February, 2026;***
and finally,
- III. ***Rs.1,00,000/- shall be paid by the respondent to the petitioner as 3rd installment on or before 31st March, 2026.***

[5] In view of the above, as agreed by the respondent, to pay the balance amount of installments, list this matter on **31st March, 2026**.

[6] It is needless to mention that the respondent shall keep proper acknowledgment of receipt of such payment to the petitioner, so that, the same may be produced before this Court on the next date.
