**FINAL ORDER**

1. Heard Mrs. S. Deb (Gupta), learned counsel appearing for the petitioner; Mr. Kohinoor N. Bhattacharyya, learned G.A. appearing for respondent No.1; Mr. D. Sharma, learned Addl. G.A. appearing for respondents No.2, 3 and 4; and Mr. D. Bhattacharjee, learned Senior Counsel appearing for respondent No.5. In terms of the order of this Court, the respondents appeared in person before this Court.
