Nainital in MACP No.165 of 2013.</p> <p>Before the Lok Adalat, learned counsel for the appellant submits that he does not wish to pursue the case further and that the withdrawal sheet records as follows:</p> <p><i>“The appellant/Insurance Company does not want to further pursue the matter and intends to withdraw the present appeal, reserving the right to contest any enhancement appeal, if any.”</i></p> <p>The terms of the withdrawal have been recorded in a separate sheet which shall form part of the order.
