Act, P.S. Dineshpur, District Udham Singh Nagar whereby respondent has been acquitted.</p> <p>2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the appellant makes a submission that the order impugned against which the present special leave is preferred has been passed against the appellant on the ground of want of prosecution; whereas the absence of the appellant was due to the reason that the learned counsel, who was looking after the matter could not appear because of the sad demise of his father and the appellant in return was also not aware of the this fact.</p>
