As per the office report, service upon the Respondent is stated to be secondary. However, the report submitted by the Nazarat, District Court, Udham Singh Nagar, reveals that notices were duly served upon the wife of the Respondent. The report specifically records that the wife of the Respondent-Komal Charan S/o Shri Ram Prasad, has received the summons physically, and her thumb impression is annexed to the receipt.</p> <p>3.
