Ms. Rachna, learned counsel holding brief of Mr. Aayush Gaur, learned counsel for the applicant. 2. Ms. Meenakshi Sharma, learned AGA for the State. 3. Present applicant - Harsh Verma, son of Vidya Sagar Verma is praying for anticipatory bail in reference to FIR dated 18.03.2026 bearing FIR No. 56 of 2026, Police Station - Rajpur, District - Dehradun, wherein present has been implicated for the offence punishable under Section 376 IPC. 4. On the previous date, the State was directed to get instructions what material has been collected against the applicant and also to place the suicidal note of the victim before this Court. 5. In compliance thereof, learned AGA Ms. Meenakshi Sharma, has placed the suicidal note before this Court and in addition to this certain whats app chats were also shown by learned counsel for the applicant. 6. After perusing the suicidal note and whats app chat, this Court is of the view that matter requires scrutiny. 7. In such view of the matter, let the State may file counter affidavit within four weeks. Two weeks, thereafter is granted to the applicant to file rejoinder affidavit. 8. Admittedly, investigation is going on, however, there is apprehension of arrest, in reference to FIR the applicant and victim known to each other, since last six years, this Court is of the view that applicant deserves for interim protection. 9. In such view of the matter for an interim measure in the event of arrest of the applicant, he shall be released on interim bail on executing a personal bond to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer / Arresting Officer concerned, subject to the following condition: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Applicant shall cooperate with the

investigating agency and he shall make himself available for interrogation by the police officer as and when required.

ii. Applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case.
