By the instant writ petition, the petitioners are praying for quashing of the FIR dated 29.10.2025, bearing Case Crime No. 0133 of 2025, registered at P.S. Selaqui, District Dehradun wherein the petitioners have been implicated for the offences punishable under Sections 120B, 406, 420 and 504 IPC. 3. It is argued by the learned counsel for the petitioners that the allegations, as alleged, are purely civil in nature and some of the amount has already been paid to the respondent/complainant and the petitioners are ready to pay the remaining amount also. 4. Ms. Sweta Badola Dobhal, learned Brief Holder accepts notice for respondent no. 1 and 2. 5. Issue notice to respondent no. 3. 6. Steps to be taken within three days. 7. In the meantime, let the investigation may go on, however, the petitioners shall not be arrested, provided they cooperate with the investigation. 8. Further, learned counsel for the petitioners informed to the Court that look out circular have been issued against the petitioners. 9. In such view of the matter, since, interim protection has been granted to the petitioners subject to this condition that the petitioners shall cooperate with the investigation, the lookout circular, if any,

shall remain in abeyance, however, the petitioners shall not leave the country without leave of the Court.

10. Put up this matter on 19.03.2026. By that time the respondent may file counter affidavit.
