Appellant was convicted for offence punishable under Section 20 (b) (ii) (B) of the NDPS Act, vide judgment and order dated 21.02.2026, passed by the court of learned Special Sessions Judge (NDPS Act)/Sessions Judge, Champawat in Special Session Trial No.09 of 2021, "State Vs. Ankit Rai and another" (FIR No.123 of 2020). Challenging his conviction and sentence, Appellant has filed this appeal.</p> <p>4. Learned counsel for the Appellant submits that during the course of trial, the Appellant was on bail. He further submits that co-accused, namely, Ankit Rai, was granted bail by this Court in CRLA No.122 of 2026, vide order dated 20.03.2026.</p> <p>5. Considering the overall facts and circumstances of the case, the Appellant has made out a case for bail.</p> <p>6. Consequently, the bail application is allowed. Let the Appellant/Applicant, be released on bail, on his executing a personal bond and furnishing two reliable sureties, each of the like amounts to the satisfaction of the Court concerned.</p> <p>7. Admit.</p> <p>8. Let the Trial Court Record be called for. After receipt of the TCR, let paper-book be prepared and supplied to the learned counsel for the parties on the payment of usual charges.</p> <p>9.
