Mr. S.C. Dumka, learned AGA, for the State of Uttarakhand/1.</p> <p>3. The applicant in the present C528 application of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, is challenging the impugned order dated 30.01.2026 passed by the court of learned FTSC/Additional Sessions Judge, Haridwar in Session Trial No.99 of 2024, "State Vs. Vivek Bakshi" under Sections 64 (1) of the BNS, 2023, whereby the application filed by the Applicant under section 348 BNSS/311 of CrPC, has been rejected due to which the Applicant could not cross-examine the PW-1 (Victim).</p> <p>4. Admit.</p> <p>5. Learned State Counsel submits that the ample opportunity has been provided to the Applicant and there are no grounds for allowing the present C528 application.</p> <p>6. Considering the overall facts and circumstances of the case, an interference is being called for in the matter.</p> <p>7. Issue notice to the Respondent No.2. Steps to be taken within a week. Counter affidavit to be filed within a period of three weeks.</p> <p>8. Till the next date of listing, the effect and operation of the impugned order dated 30.01.2026 passed by the court of learned FTSC/Additional Sessions Judge, Haridwar in Session Trial No.99 of 2024, "State Vs. Vivek Bakshi" under Sections 64 (1) of the BNS, 2023, shall remain stayed. However, it is made clear that the interim relief application shall not be a tool to prolong the matter. In default, interim order shall stand vacated.</p>

9. List this matter on 15.05.2026.

10. Stay application (IA No.1/2026) stands disposed of accordingly.
