Mr. Akshay Latwal, learned AGA with Mr. Nikhil Bisht, learned Brief Holder, for the State of Uttarakhand/1. 3. The Applicant in the present C528 application of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, is challenging the impugned order dated 12.02.2026 passed by the court of learned Civil Judge/Judicial Magistrate Chakrata in Misc. Criminal Case No.13/2025, “Ramesh Chandra Joshi Vs. Parshuram Joshi” under section 175 (3) of the BNSS, 2023. 4. Admit. 5. Learned State Counsel submits that the matter cannot be entertained as against the aforesaid order revision would lie. To this, learned counsel for the Applicant has placed reliance to the judgment passed by the Hon’ble Apex Court in the case of “Raj Kapoor and others Vs. State and others” reported in 1980 (1) SCC 43. 6. Considering the overall facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that the Applicant is 84 years of age, an interference is being called for in the matter. 7. Issue notice to the Respondent No.2. Steps to be taken within a week. Counter affidavit to be filed within a period of three weeks. 8. Till the next date of listing, the effect and operation of the impugned order dated 12.02.2026 passed by the court of learned Civil Judge/Judicial Magistrate Chakrata in Misc. Criminal Case No.13/2025, “Ramesh Chandra Joshi Vs. Parshuram Joshi” under section 175 (3) of the BNSS, 2023, shall remain stayed. However,
