The present Application has been moved on behalf of the Applicant, who is in jail in connection with FIR No. 188 of 2025, for offences punishable under Sections 109 and 3(5) of the B.N.S.S., 2023, and under Sections 3/25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Pantnagar, District Udham Singh Nagar.</p> <p>4. Learned counsel appearing for the Applicant submits at the outset that the Applicant has been falsely implicated in the present matter. It is further submitted that the Applicant himself sustained injuries and has no role, as alleged against him, in relation to the alleged offence of attempt to murder.</p> <p>5. Learned State Counsel, however, opposes the submissions so advanced by the learned counsel for the Applicant and submits that the Applicant was involved in the firing incident against police personnel. It is further submitted that the injuries sustained by the Applicant were caused during the exchange of fire, in self-defence by the police.
