The sole grievance raised by petitioner is that she was entitled to be included in the seniority list of Assistant Teacher serving in Urban Area, whereas her name has not been included in any of the seniority list.</li> <li>4. Learned State Counsel, however, submits that petitioner has nowhere pleaded in the writ petition that there are separate lists maintained in respect of Urban and Rural Area.</li> <li>5. Learned State Counsel is directed to get definite instructions as to whether there is separate seniority list maintained in respect of Assistant Teacher, Elementary School serving in Urban and Rural Areas. He shall also get instructions as to whether, in the past, there was any such practice of maintaining separate seniority lists, if separate lists are not presently being maintained.</li> <li>6.
