The Applicant is in judicial custody in connection with FIR No. 0040 of 2025, registered at Police Station Chamba, District Tehri Garhwal, for the offences punishable under Sections 8/20 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (hereinafter referred to as the “NDPS Act”).</p> <p>4. Learned counsel for the Applicant submits that the Applicant has been falsely implicated in the present matter and that there are material irregularities in the mandatory procedure required to be followed with respect to the arrest and seizure.</p> <p>5.
