Chauhan, learned DAG with Mr. Vikash Uniyal, learned AGA, for the State of Uttarakhand.</p> <p>3. In the High Court of Uttarakhand, the present case arises from Bail Application filed under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, seeking regular bail for the Applicant – Jahur @ Jawal, who has been accused in Case Crime No.94 of 2026, under Sections 3, 5 read with Section 11 of the Uttarakhand Protection of Cow Progeny Act, at Police Station Pathri, District Haridwar.</p> <p>4. Learned counsel for the Applicant submits that the Applicant has falsely been implicated in the present matter and has been made scapegoat.</p> <p>5. Considering the overall facts and circumstances of the case, the Applicant has made out a case for bail.</p> <p>6. Accordingly, bail application is allowed. It is directed that the Applicant - Jahur @ Jawal, who has been accused in Case Crime No.94 of 2026, under Sections 3, 5 read with Section 11 of the Uttarakhand Protection of Cow Progeny Act, at Police Station Pathri, District Haridwar, be released on bail on furnishing a personal bond with two reliable sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of the concerned court.
