Appellant was convicted for offence punishable under Sections 489-B and 489-C of IPC vide judgment and order dated 27.02.2026, passed by the court of learned First Additional Session Judge, Roorkee, District Haridwar in Session Trial No.20 of 2018, "State Vs. Irtaza and another". Challenging his conviction and sentence, Appellant has filed this appeal.</p> <p>4. Learned counsel for the Appellant submits that during the course of trial, the Appellant was on bail and at present the Appellant is also in interim bail. After receipt of the TCR, let paper-book be prepared and supplied to the learned counsel for the parties on the payment of usual charges.</p> <p>9.
